As Scientists we shall:

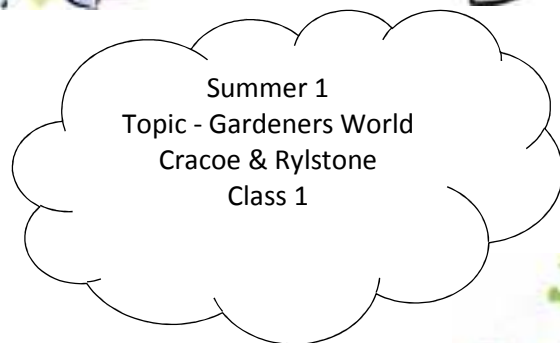
- Be finding out about seasonal change
