




Home School Partnership

Overview and Outcomes for the term

Across the autumn term, the children will explore, discover and deepen their knowledge through our exciting curriculum. Our Topic this term is called Be Brave and Bold and we will be exploring people from the past who changed the world. We will also be looking at people who help us today including the police and fire services. Our topic will inspire our writing and help us to create our own stories along with instruction texts and poetry. Through our RE work the children will explore what it is like to belong to a faith and in Science we will focus on our senses along with exploring seasonal changes in our environment. Throughout the Autumn term there will be many different learning outcomes – far too many to list here- but here are a few to look out for.

Some of the main outcomes of Be Bold and Brave will be:

- To sequence events in their own lives
- To learn about heroes in everyday life- police fire, medical and rescue services.
- To investigate the lives of famous people.
- To explore significant events including the Great Fire of London.

Some of the main outcomes of our Science topic of Plants will be:

- To be able to label the main parts of our body.
- To investigate our senses
- To learn about our brains and how they help us to learn.
- To investigate the changing seasons.

Some of the main outcomes of our Art and Design topics will be:

- To explore colour mixing.
- To create mood pictures using both paint and ICT.
- To contribute art work to our Harvest festival.
